

Regarding the Use of Hoko-en-Park

【Park Usage Guidelines】

- Please take all garbage with you when leaving the park.
- Do not damage or soil plants or facilities in the park, including breaking branches of cherry trees or other vegetation.
- The use of drones is prohibited (except by operators authorized by the city).
- Do not occupy areas that block passage for long periods of time.
- Direct fires (campfires directly on the ground) are prohibited.
- Open flames are strictly prohibited under roofs or in locations with an ignition risk.
- Overnight stays in the park are prohibited.
- Selling goods, soliciting donations, or performing other acts of commerce without permission is prohibited.
- Behaviors that exceed normal park use, such as unauthorized exclusive use of parts or the entirety of the park, are prohibited.
- Any individuals using flames in inappropriate areas or occupying inappropriate spaces may be asked by staff to relocate.
- Fireworks are prohibited after 10:00 PM.
- Fireworks are limited to handheld types only; use of aerial fireworks, rocket fireworks, etc., is not permitted.
- When using fireworks, please do so on dirt, sand, or asphalt-paved surfaces. Using fireworks on grass, vegetation, indoor areas, or other locations with potential fire hazards is prohibited.
- Always prepare water for extinguishing fireworks, and be sure to take all burnt remnants and other trash with you when finished.
- Driving vehicles into areas other than designated parking spaces is prohibited (this includes motorcycles and mopeds, except for emergency vehicles).
- During crowded times, please use the pre-payment machine when leaving the parking area.
- For safety reasons, the use of skateboards and similar devices (including caster boards and kickboards) is prohibited in the parking lot, tennis court, and surrounding areas, as well as Ganryu Square.
