# The 2025 Census will be conducted

The Population Census, Japan's most important statistical survey, is conducted every five years and will take place on October 1st of this year.

This important survey not only provides basic data useful for various measures essential to our daily lives, such as improving living environments and disaster prevention plans, but is also widely used in a variety of fields, including private companies and research institutions. Responding to the census is mandatory under the Statistics Act. We ask for your cooperation in helping to create a livable city.

**How to respond to the survey:** Enumerators will visit each household in late September and distribute survey documents. Please respond online, or mail or submit a paper questionnaire to an enumerator.

# **Protection of Personal Information:**

The Statistics Act stipulates strict protection of personal information for the census, and enumerators are required to maintain confidentiality. Submitted questionnaires are strictly managed, and online responses are protected by strict security measures, so your information is safe and secure.

# A request to dog owners

Do not let dogs roam free or walk them off-leash! Leaving dogs free can be very frightening and dangerous for people who don't like dogs. Please do not let dogs roam free.

**Always clean up feces and urine!** Leaving feces while walking is a nuisance to many people. When walking, be sure to carry equipment to clean up feces and urine, and take the feces home with you to clean up.

**Don't let your dog bark unnecessarily!** If your dog barks for a long period of time, it will cause a nuisance to your neighbors. Consider your dog's training and where it should be kept to prevent it from barking unnecessarily.





# Hospitality screenings: "Breast cancer screening" and

# "Cervical cancer screening" will be conducted

Breast cancer is most prevalent among women in their 40s and 50s, and overall cases have roughly doubled in the past 20 years. Cervical cancer, on the other hand, increases sharply from the 20s onwards. Both types of cancer strike women in the prime of their working lives. This year, Nagahama Well Center will be offering breast cancer and cervical cancer screenings as a welcome checkup. (There will be no screenings at hotels this year.)

**Date and Time**: Sunday, October 19<sup>th</sup>

**Registration**: 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM 1:00 PM - 3:00 PM

**Location**: Nagahama Well Center (Kobori-cho)

**Contents**: Medical interview, breast awareness talk, and on-board screening.

Eliqibility: Breast cancer screening: Female residents aged 40 or older who have not undergone city-wide breast cancer screening in the previous year.

Cervical cancer screening: Female residents aged 20 or older who have not undergone city-wide cervical cancer screening in the previous year.

\*\*Those with symptoms, those under medical observation, and those who were previously required to undergo further examination but have not yet undergone further examination are not eligible for screening.

# We are now accepting applications for After-school Childcare Clubs for the 2026 fiscal year

# Kousetsu Houkago Jidou Club / Public after-school children's club

★Only children attending elementary schools within the city are eligible to attend. However, as a general rule, this is only possible if the parent or family member is unable to look after the child after school due to work or other reasons.

\*\*Applications are also required for those currently attending an after-school children's club and wishing to continue attending, those on a waiting list, and those entering first grade next year. Those wishing to start attending mid-school or only during long holidays should also apply during this period.

Reception locations and hours: Each after-school childcare center: Weekdays 2:00 PM - 6:00 PM

Child and Family Support Division (Main Building, 5th floor), Kurashi-madoguchika (Northern Government Building): Weekdays 9:00 AM - 4:45 PM

Applications can also be submitted by registered mail or online.

**Documents to be submitted**: Application form, consent form, employment certificate, etc.

\*The necessary documents can be collected at the reception desk above or downloaded from the city's website.

◆If the number of applicants exceeds the capacity, selection will be made from among those who submit an application form within the period. In addition, priority will be given to younger children and children who require special support, so older children may not be able to attend depending on the situation at the facility.

◆For elementary schools that do not yet have a public club, if there are 10 or more children who wish to attend throughout the year, we will consider opening a public club at that school.

# 2026 Kindergarten, Nursery School, and Certified Childcare Facility Enrollment

**Distribution begins**: Monday, September 8th. The guidebook and application forms are available at each kindergarten, nursery school, certified childcare center, Early Childhood Care Division, and Lifestyle Support Division (1st floor, Northern Government Building), as well as on the city's website.

Application period: Tuesday, October 7th - Friday, October 17th, weekdays, 9:00 AM - 4:45 PM

Hoikusho - Nintei Kodomoen [Choujibu] /Nursery School Certified Childcare [Center Long-term section]

Target ages: 0 to 5 years old. 

\*Childcare ages (in months) vary by nursery.

5-year-olds: April 2, 2020 to April 1, 2021.
4-year-olds: April 2, 2021 to April 1, 2022.
3-year-olds: April 2, 2022 to April 1, 2023.
2-year-olds: April 2, 2023 to April 1, 2024.
1-year-olds: April 2, 2024 to April 1, 2025.
0-year-olds: Born April 2, 2025 and up.

**Eligible children:** Children of the target age whose parents or cohabitants have difficulty caring for them at home due to work, illness, nursing care, etc.

**Reception location:** First choice nursery school %If you are unable to submit to the nursery school, you can also submit at Yojika/Early Childhood Affairs Division or tKurashi-madoguchika.

**Documents to be submitted**: Certification application and application form, employment certificate, etc.( Nintei Shinseisho Ken Riyou Moushikomisho, Shuurou Shoumeisho, etc)

- Children aged 0-2 currently enrolled in nurseries or certified child care centers (long-hour section) are also required to apply for the 2026 school year.
- Applications for mid-year admission will not be accepted during this period. However, if you wish to enroll during the 2026 school year, please contact your first choice nursery school by Friday, October 17th.
- The number of places each nursery school is accepting will be announced on its website by the application start date. Adjustments will be made if the number of applications exceeds the number of places available.
